Core Outcomes for a System of Care for Children with Special Health Care Needs

- Coordinated ongoing comprehensive care within a "medical home"
- Adequate private or public health insurance
- Early and continuous screening
- ★ Organization of services so families can use them easily
- ★ Families partner in decision-making at all levels and are satisfied with the services they receive
- Youth receive services needed for successful transition to adulthood

FPPI: Goals and objectives

- To build system capacity for family-professional partnerships
- To help families and organizations/ agencies to establish family-professional partnerships that impact policy and programs
 - ▶ Builds on our experience with the Family Partners Initiative: Both families and orgs need training and support → Supports built into Institute
 - Develop a cadre of parents able to partner and organizations that see the need for and benefits of partnership

What is the FPPI?

- Opportunity to build systemic capacity to recruit, train & support interested families and organizations
- Serve as a broker/matchmaker
- Develop 4-6 new partnerships each year
- Explore a variety of models and mechanisms for partnerships
- Broadly disseminate methodology and lessons learned

Multiple benefits

- To families: Help develop system that works best for families, one with which they are satisfied because they are part of the design and delivery
- To organizations: Understand the opportunities and benefits that result from partnering with families
- To the system: Build capacity, broaden way we think about developing policies and programs, to ensure they are responsive to real needs, real children and families
